
INITIAL SURVEY RESULTS

Approx 30% kids/young adults





• What recreation activities do you participate in at the St. Kilda








PRIMARY SCHOOLS (TOP 14 ANSWERS)






SECONDARY SCHOOLS (TOP 14 ANSWERS)

Clearly designated area but still reflects foreshore promenade form


Sculptural, contained space that caters for a range of users and levels of expertise



MASTER PLAN ACTIONS

Provide security level lighting across whole park to match promenade

Provide sports lighting to play and active space during early evenings as per normal sports lighting conditions

Provide a possible long term pedestrian crossing across Marine Parade from Blessington Street to site Provide temporary bicycle path to eastern edge of reserve until on road cycling rolled out
