

Marina Reserve Masterplan Operations Plan



What are your ideas for the future management of Marina Reserve?

Following CMA (Coastal Management Act 1995) approval for the Marina Reserve Masterplan, Council is developing a operations plan and is seeking community input.

The operations plan will cover all day to day use, management and maintenance of the car park, gates, toilet, skateable infrastructure, bbqs and/or any other areas within the reserve.

Below topics relating to the operations of the reserve were raised during public consultation on the draft masterplan. These and several other topics have been included in this preliminary list:

Management topics	What they could cover
Car park	Enforcement of parking restrictions
Gates	Hours of opening and closing
Toilet	Hours of operations
Camping on the foreshore	Current protocol to deal with campers
Litter bins	Litter bin cleaning regime
Skateable infrastructure area	Signage Emergency access Cleaning (including drainage, storm events, sand build up, etc)
BBQ	Cleaning regime
Construction phase	Hours of construction Minimisation of impact on nearby residents (in relation to noise, dust, etc)
Dogs off leash	Council policy and proposed response if issues arise
Public safety	Response to anti-social behaviour
Maintenance issues	Response to wear and tear Response to graffiti Response to vandalism Garden and lawn care
Launch of Marina Reserve works	How the works are to be launched.
Events	What type of events are allowed and how are they going to be managed
