- 2 Prior to any alteration or modification of the endorsed plan, the owners of the properties at Nos 44 and 48 Tennyson Street shall be notified that an alteration or modification is proposed.
- 3 The area set aside for the parking of vehicles, together with the associated access lanes as delineated on the endorsed plan shall:
- 3.1 be provided and completed to the satisfaction of the Responsible Authority prior to the commencement of the use hereby permitted;
- 3.2 thereafter be maintained to the satisfaction of the Responsible Authority;
- 3.3 be made available for such use at all times and not used for any other purpose;
- 3.4 be properly formed to such levels that it can be used in accordance with the plan;
- 3.5 be adequately drained and maintained continuously in a usable condition;
- 3.6 have the boundaries of all vehicle spaces clearly indicated on the ground in conformity with the endorsed plan.
- The area set aside for landscaping on the endorsed plan shall be planted and maintained to the satisfaction of the Responsible Authority.
- 5 Without the prior written consent of the Responsible Authority, the use hereby permitted shall operate only between the hours of 7.30am to 10.00pm daily.
- All children attending the child minding centre shall be below school age. 6
- All side and rear fencing of the property shall be 1.6 metres in height and shall comply with the Child Minding Regulations under the Health Act.
