



Project Opportunities

Play experiences

- New play equipment unit, compliant with current play standards featuring new play elements including a rope climbing structure and and bridge and favourites such as slides of different heights and a shopfront
- New double swing with standard seat and baby seat
- New spring toy and nature play elements
- Rubber softfall matting to areas of most wear

Park amenities

- New accessible pathway linking the main reserve entry to the play areas, picnic setting, drinking fountain and bin.
- Refurbished seating
- New accessible drinking fountain and picnic setting

Natural elements

- Large lawn area for informal play
- Improve the health of the existing mature trees by relocating play areas and park amenities away from the tree protection zones
- New trees to replace existing trees in poor condition/ at end-of-life (as advised by arborists)
- Native shrub and groundcover planting
