The project will see an expansion and refurbishment of the South Melbourne library to become the Emerald Hill Library and Heritage Centre with more books, a local history focus and better access for community groups.

Mayor Rachel Powning said the council was encouraging feedback from the entire community, including the city's youngest readers.
