

- Proposed small picnic area, with potential for fluttering leaf canopy over. Decorative stone lear paving and new tree planting.
- 2 Carousel / roundabout with seats
- 3 Single point support basket swing
- 4 Potential for tree sucession planting around edge of space
- 5 Bench seats some with arms or backs. Two with narrow cafe
- 6 Acorn sculptures at ground level

- Double swing frame with Joey seat for an adult and child to swing together, and toddler seat
- 8 Double swing frame with strap seats
- 9 Net-based agility equipment, with steel posts that mimic grass leaves, and natural timber posts
- 10 Sensory leaf panels separate swing area from path
- 11 Bike racks & twin bin enclosures

- Sand coloured porous asphalt raised to top of kerb
- 13 Drinking fountain (relocated from lawn)
- 14 New oak to maintain symettry of tree canopy
- Proposed circular link path defines open areas of 15 lawn and provides access and supervision spaces for both areas of playspace, and cohesive access to Tennis Club building
- 16 Potential for botanical mural on side of building
- Sandpit with sand sieve, accessible digger and raised accessible sand play table. Paving adjacent to lawn patterned with leaf imprints.
- 18 Upper level freestanding treehouse, with wooden pommel climber, spiral slide, linked to main treehouse with rope bridge.
- Freestanding accessible treehouse with structure under deck to 19 resemble branches of trees, like fan-vault. Access via ramp, steps and enclosed ladder through deck. Includes lounging net , double open slide and various entry points to ramp.
- 20 Inground round bouncers
- Natural balancing elements through low 21 garden bed planting to protect trees. Include leaf decks and fairy log.
- Leap frog mounds (synthetic coated) link 22 area between turnover bars and grass-stalk hammock
- Green toned softfall rubber provides accessible path
